1. The name of such corporation is International Order of Good Templars Fire Department of Riverton Riverton Volunteer Fire Department

2. The object for which it is formed is to protect lives and property in the village of Riverton against fire.

3. The management of the aforesaid Association shall be vested in a Board of Three Directors, who are to be elected indefinitely



4. The following persons are hereby selected as the Directors to control and manage said corporation for the first year of its corporate existence, viz:

5. The location is in the city of Riverton in the County of Sangamon in the State of Illinois, and the postoffice address of its business office is at No. 207 1/2 Street, in the said city of Riverton
